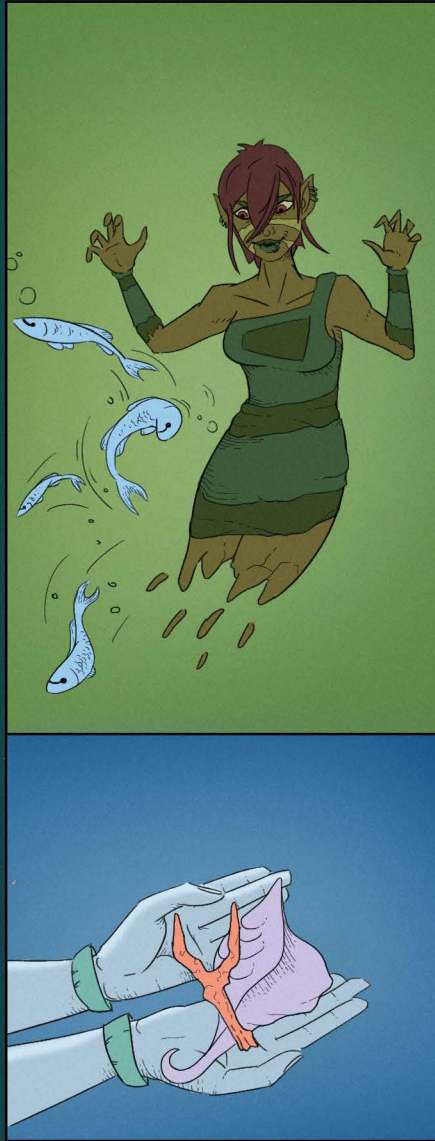
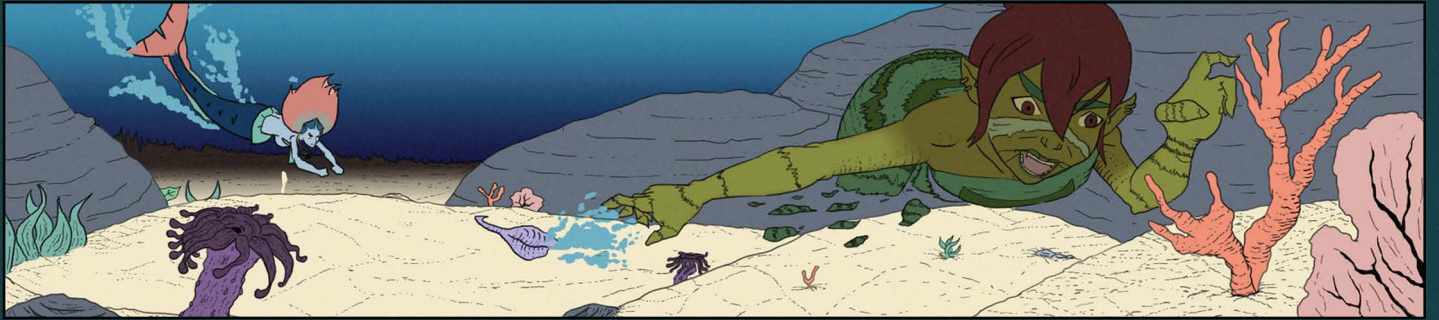


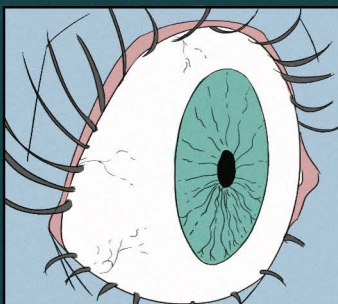
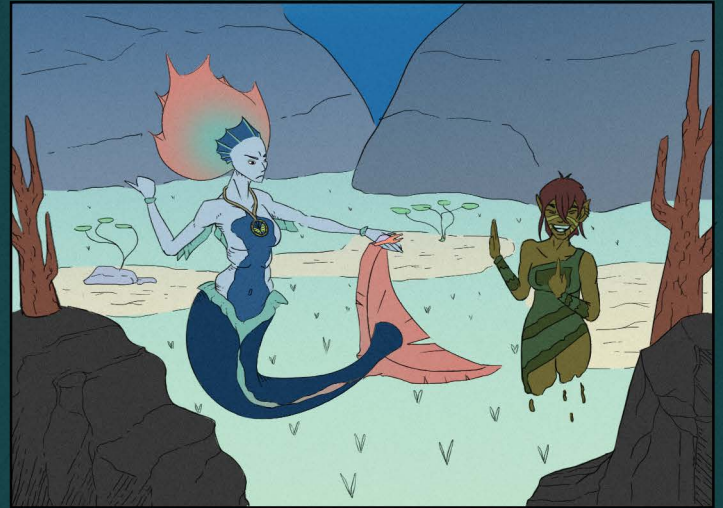




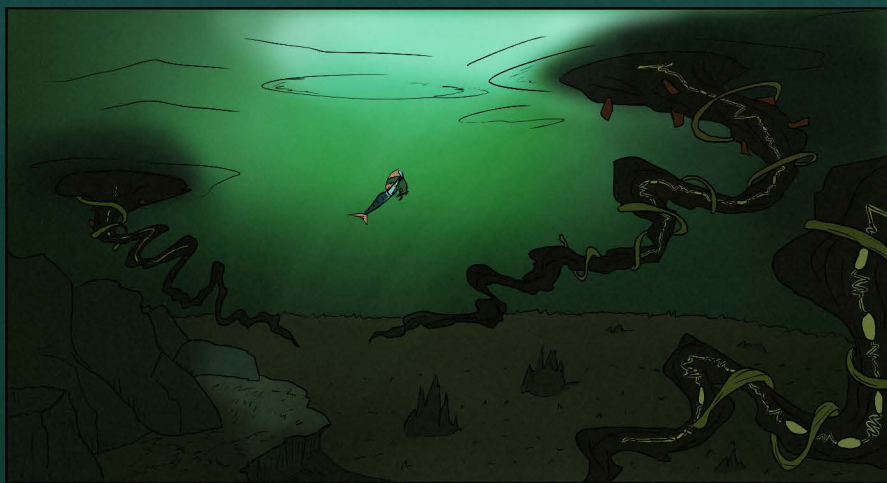


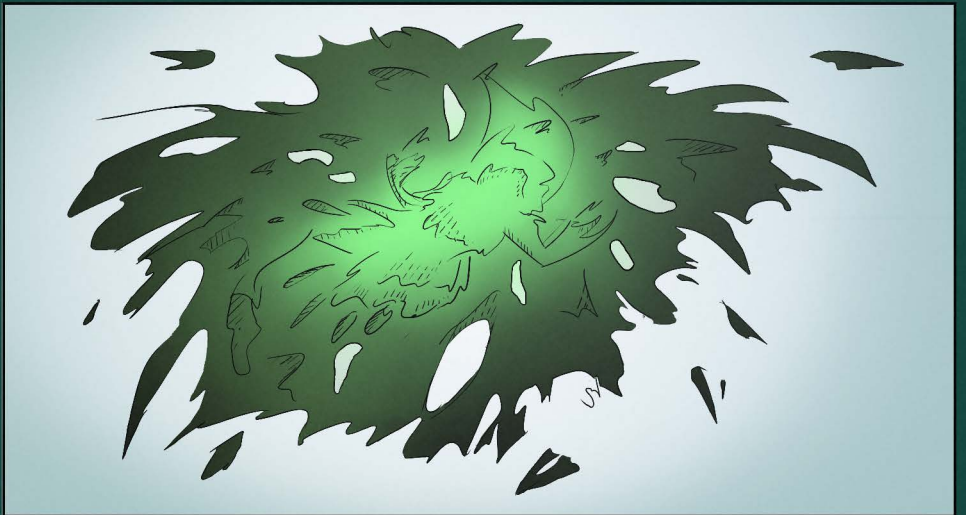
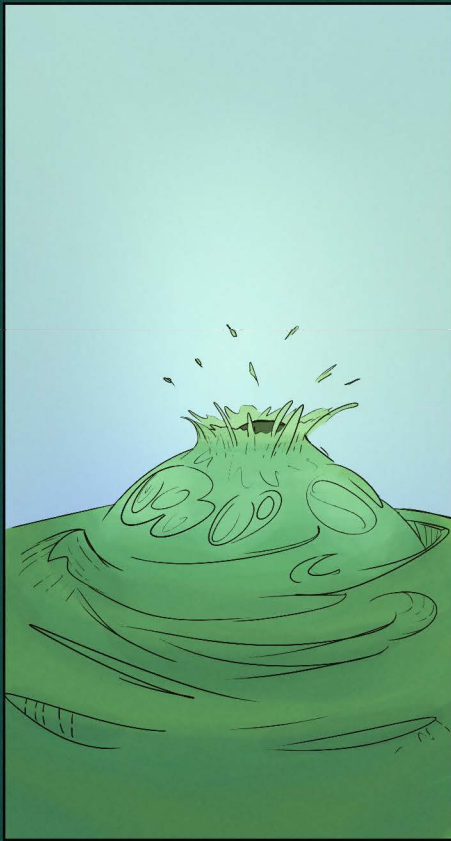


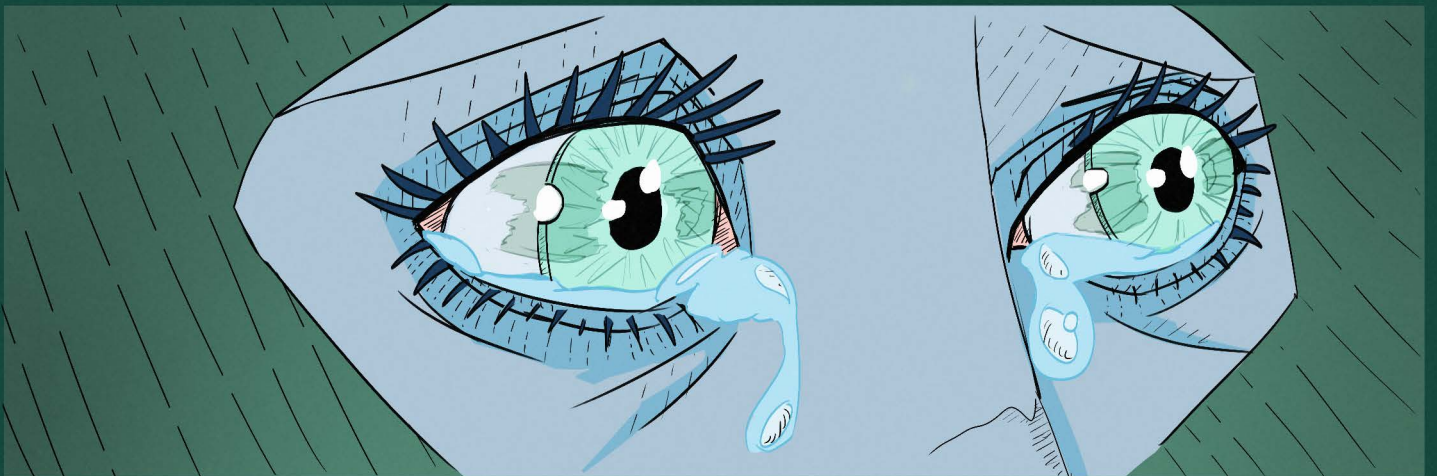












ABOUT 60%-80% OF ALL MARINE DEBRIS IS COMPOSED OF PLASTIC AND OCEAN CONSERVANCY'S TRASH FREE SEAS ALLIANCE ESTIMATES THAT 8 MILLION METRIC TONS OF PLASTIC ENTERS THE OCEAN EACH YEAR.

IT HAS BEEN ESTIMATED THAT PLASTIC MARINE DEBRIS ADVERSELY AFFECTS AT LEAST 267 SPECIES GLOBALLY, INCLUDING 86% OF SEA TURTLES, 44% OF SEABIRDS, AND 43% OF MARINE MAMMALS.

REDUCTION OF WASTE AND THE ECO-FRIENDLY DISPOSAL OF REFUSE IS GOING TO HAVE THE BIGGEST EFFECT ON RIGHTING THIS WRONG.
